



Managing Behaviour/Physical Intervention Policy and Procedure

My policy is to promote positive behaviour. Children will be encouraged to be kind and considerate to each other and to have respect for materials and equipment. I will be a positive role model at all times. I will praise children when they behave well and encourage them. I will never use any form of physical punishment. Nor will I ever humiliate or isolate a child. If I were to use any form of physical intervention with a child it would be to stop them hurting themselves, others or damaging property. The parent/carer would be informed on the same day if this were to happen and a physical intervention form will be completed.

Children are treated equally, and will be taught that there are boundaries to be observed and that simple, consistent rules must be kept. To help the children feel they are included in our home we will set some house rules together with the children. I will listen to what the children have to say and I will make myself clear giving an explanation of what behaviour was unacceptable and why, so they understand the consequences of their actions.
